BRAUCHEREI IN THE URGLAawe CONTEXT

The heirloom healing Deitsch (Pennsylvania German) practice of Braucherei (also called Powwow in English) and the related magical practice of Hexerei serve as tremendous folk resources for the Heathen denomination of Urglaawe. Long the front line of folk medicine for the Deitsch people, Braucherei is pre-Christian at its core and features overlays from Gnostic, Judeo-Christian, and Lenape traditions. The practitioner communities also retained a large volume of oral lore in the form of myths, "superstitions," charms, etc. The Urglaawe movement arose from these living traditions as well as from the wider Deitsch folk religion. The Urglaawe community has completed several years of research and work to isolate the native Heathen elements and to organize them in a manner that is more accessible to the Urglaawe community inside and outside of Pennsylvania. The Guild of Urglaawe Practitioners of Braucherei and Hexerei consists of various specialties within the traditions: Fiber Arts, Music, Culinary, Customs, Artisans, Energetic and Sympathetic Healing, and Herbalism (with more to come). This workshop will feature a brief background and description of the Braucherei and will serve as an entry point into the guild for those interested.

Robert L. Schreiwier is the current Assistant Steer for the Troth, the Program Coordinator of The Troth's In-Reach Heathen Prison Services program, and the Troth Steward for Eastern Pennsylvania and New York. He is also a founder of the Heathen denomination of Urglaawe, Ziewer (godsmen) of Distelfink Sippschaft, a trained practitioner of the Pennsylvania German healing tradition of Braucherei. Through the Pennsylvania German Heathen Alliance for the Urglaawe, he has been conducting a project to gather oral lore from all regions of Deitsch (Pennsylvania German) settlement. He was an Instructor of Pennsylvania German at Kutztown University in 2008-2009, and he is currently working on other language advancement projects.

CREATE YOUR OWN LENORMAND DECK!

In this workshop, participants will not only learn how to create a Lenormand Cartomancy deck from a regular deck of playing cards, they will also be able to begin the process of creating their deck! Attendees will each receive a standard deck of playing cards as part of the workshop to take home with them.

Helena Domenic was born in Italy, where she developed an eye for beauty, art and the magical early in life. An accomplished artist and seer, Helena's art has been exhibited around the United States and abroad. Her specialties are Tarot, Qabala, and Art and the Sacred, and African art. Helena is the creator of the Fellowship of the Fool Tarot and author of The Fellowship of the Fool Tarot Book, and her as yet un-named new Lenormand deck. Helena also maintains a blog at Pagan Square on Paganism and Art History. In day to day life, Helena is an Assistant Professor of Art and Art History at Cheyney University of Pennsylvania. Helena has also taught at a variety of other venues, including Sacred Space and Pantheacon, among others. Her work has been published in both scholarly and Pagan journals.

She has authored several books and her writings have been published Internationally. DRUIDISM VS. WICCA: A BALANCED COMPARISON

The true and ancient histories of Wicca and Druidism have been lost to the mists of time, but we do know a lot about the histories of their modern revivals. In fact, two of the most important founders were buddies that hung out together at a nudist camp in the English countryside in the 1920's and 30's. In this relaxed and illuminating workshop we'll discuss many of the similarities and a few of the key differences between modern Wicca and modern Druidism.

Bard Dafydd is the Senior Druid of Red Oak Grove, ADF. He's a professional trainer, storyteller, and speaker. Within ADF he has held the offices of Vice ArchDruid, Chief of the Council of Senior Druids, Chief of the Welsh Kin, Chief Seer and Chief Bard – but not all at the same time! WORKSHOPS

THE ELEMENTS AND QUARTERS: AN INTIMATE LOOK

This is an in depth look at the Four Sacred Elements, their power, potential, correspondences, and Monarchs. Experience them in a new way as we study. Discuss and ultimately journey to them in guided meditations.

AN HERBAL SAMPLER: MEDICINE AND MAGICK

This workshop has two parts. The first will present basic herbal preparations such as infusions, decoctions, poultices, tinctures, and infused oils. The second will present some magickal herb preparations such as incense, sachets, dream pillows, and bath salts for purification.

Carm DiLullo is a Third Degree Initiate of the Assembly of the Sacred Wheel, serving as the High Priestess of Moonfire. Professionally, Carm holds a Masters Degree in Education and a Bachelors in Laboratory Science. She teaches several science disciplines at an inner city high school. In addition to professional teaching, for over 25 years she has served the Mother in her work at a wildlife rehabilitation clinic, caring for injured and orphaned animals. Carm is a herbologist, teaching both magical and medicinal herbology. She is an avid gardener, an amateur homesteader, a student and practitioner of Tarot, and a Fire Scryer. As an environmentalist and magickal practitioner, Carm finds great spirituality in the quest for sustainability and balance.

INTRODUCTION TO THERIANTHROPY

Introduction to Therianthropy is a ground-breaking discussion and exercise for finding one's animal totem and discovering your deeper bond with your animal's mentality and spirit. Based on meditation, the exercise portion of this presentation will be very enlightening and help you on your path to self-discovery. Everyone has a spirit guide, only some of them are therians; this workshop will help you discover if this practice is right for you, and Everwood Pack members will be helping afterward if you have any questions.

Serenity Ookami is a practicing Druidic Wolf-Therian, who has been active in the Otherkin and Therian subcultures for nearly 7 years, and the Pagan community for 8 years. She has presented online courses for the Way of the Wolf (an introduction to Wolf Therianthropy) 2 years in a row with noted success, and is in the process of writing a book on the subject. She is also the founding Matriarch and Alpha Female of the Everwood Pack (PA & NJ).

LOVE'S CONFLICT RESOLUTION: THE THREE WAY MIRROR

The Three Way Mirror is a way to analyze and potentially resolve conflict by using the Mirror analogy. Rather than simply seeing the one 'reflection' we open clients to viewing the other two panes of the mirror.

The 45 minute interactive Workshop introduces the concept, and describes all of the panes in the mirror. It concludes with giving participants tools to successfully process and resolve each of the presenting panes of the mirror. A handout will be provided to participants.

MANTRA FOR MAGICAL TRANSFORMATION

Mantra or sacred utterances have been used for centuries by cultures for everything from attaining goals to shifting into higher levels of consciousness. These songs of heart give us the power to ward off evils, attract abundance, cultivate magical experience, worship deity for exalted communion, or aid us in attaining blissful state of liberation.

Join Erick for this introduction to mantra for magical transformation as we trace a brief history of mantras and demystify them for daily use. He will guide participants on a journey through cultivating intention and exploration of sacred sounds and chants from both traditional Sanskrit and Tibetan sources to the use modern "remixed" sounds, while inviting the playful discovery of how mantra can be used as a tool to compliment your existing magical workings or cultivate a new practice. Together, Erick will breakdown the myth around "to sing or not to sing" but singing is NOT required for this workshop.

Participants will leave with a foundational knowledge of mantra through a contemporary western lens. Several new mantras to try at home, as well as two hand-outs. Beginners Welcome. Come with an open heart, no singing experience is needed.

Erick DuPree is a published author, mantra, meditation, and yoga teacher in the Philadelphia area. He is an initiate of Reclaiming Collective and draws inspiration and spirit from his teachers T. Thorn Coyle, Douglas Brooks, Yeshe Rabbit Matthews, Ivo Dominguez, Jr. and Joan Hallifax.

SQUARE OF ABEYANCE

Castings can be used to mark out sacred space or create environments conducive to magickal work. The casting known as the square of abeyance is designed to dampen energies that do not originate on the manifest plane. Why would you want to use such a tool? Maybe you want to get rid of an unwanted entity, or see if you are under the influence of baneful practices, or psychic attack. This class will be broken into two parts, the first part a discussion of the uses for such a casting and the second part will teach you how to cast and use it.

Karen Schlechter is a 3rd degree initiate within the Assembly of the Sacred Wheel, (www.sacredwheel.org) a Wiccan syncretic tradition. Karen is the High Priestess of Tenders of the Earth Temple founded in 2011 and is based within Philadelphia. A practitioner of a variety of esoteric disciplines, Karen has been active in Wicca and the local Pagan community for the past 16 years. Her coven believes in getting it's fingers in the earth and works to assist local park services rehabilitating and restoring the land. Karen is also a trained Fire Tender for Sweatlodge, she has ongoing classes through Mt. Airy Learning Tree and has previously taught at Spring Magick, Philadelphia Pagan Pride and Free Spirit Gathering.

TRIBAL AND RITUAL MUSIC- FROM PREHISTORY TO PAGANFOLK

A discussion about the tribal and primitive roots of early music. Our earliest ancestors existed in an essentially pagan and shamanic environment. These ethos shaped the creation of both music and the earliest instruments. This talk will examine the movement of music from the experiential and ritual context to more formal standards. True tribal music, early music, liturgical and sacred chant, as well as modern rock and pagan folk will be discussed. In addition John will discuss his work with his band Ashagal and how to incorporate sound and music into ritual. He will demonstrate some of the early instruments that he plays.

John Harford has worked in writing, music and visual arts for over 20 years. He now lectures as well as pursuing his own creative projects. Most recently he has used both modern and ancient techniques in painting, word and music to explore our collective tribal memory.

VALHALLA'S CALL: VIKING MARTIAL ARTS IN HISTORY AND MYTH

The Vikings are one of the most misunderstood and misrepresented warrior cultures in history. Little of how they fought or how they used their weapons has survived, so historians must work with the sources they have to understand their combative nature. This hour long seminar will cover a multitude of topics including but not limited to:

- Real Viking culture and society
- The place of weapons and fighting in Viking Sagas
- Uses of Viking age weapons
- Staged interpretation of Viking duels and battles

Frank Perrin has been studying Historical Martial Arts as well as creating and performing fight choreography for ten years. His passion for historical combat and began when he was a cast member of the Connecticut Renaissance Faire where he eventually became a weapons master and fight coordinator for the cast. He is a member of Art of Combat, an international organization for stuntmen, fight choreographers and historical martial artists. He has performed for Stan Lee as well as with Hapfor Juilius Bjorson, also known as "The Mountain" in Game of Thrones. He recently founded East Coast Combative Arts, LLC. Frank Perrin works for Historic New England as the Lead Museum Teacher for Roseland Cottage and the Arnold House. He holds a Master's Degree in Public History from Central Connecticut State University.
